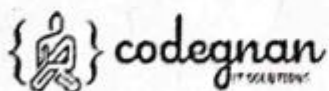

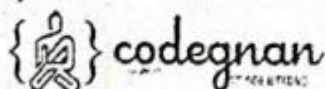

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2. Mutual Obligation

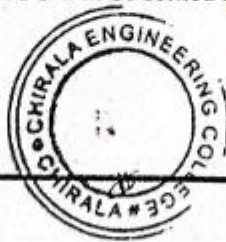

- 3.2 Each party represents that they have the full power and authority to enter into this MOU in general

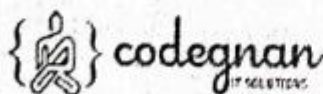
