OBJECTIVES OF GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE:

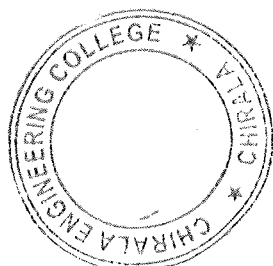
1. Encouraging the Students to express their grievances / problems freely and frankly, without any fear of being victimized.
