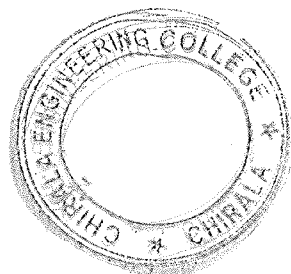

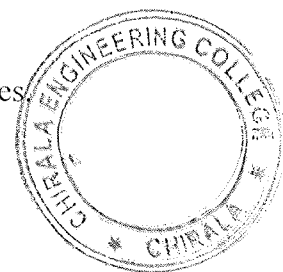
GOALS OF THE INSTITUTION:

- To keep the quality certification ISO 9001:2015 towards the quality systems and procedures.

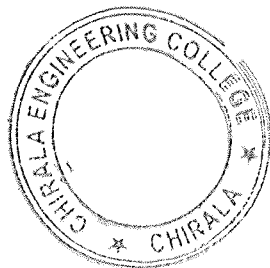
LONG TERM:

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THE EFFECTIVE LEADERSHIP IS VISIBLE IN VARIOUS INSTITUTIONAL PRACTICES SUCH AS DECENTRALIZATION AND PARTICIPATIVE MANAGEMENT:

The institute uses a decentralised governance approach to operate. The power to choose the departments activities and assign tasks to the staff members has been given to the department heads. The department makes decisions about the schedule, subject allocation, equipment purchases, upkeep, guest lectures, seminars, conferences, symposiums, and essential industrial visits, in-plant trainings, internships, and MOUs. With a culture of participatory management that encourages professors and students to voice their opinions and offer suggestions for improvement.

All academic activities are decentralized, and decisions are made after debate and deliberation in meetings of department, faculty, and HODs along with the principal and secretary. The Principal coordinates with the departments, management, and administration. Through its vast opportunities for departmental engagement, participatory management promotes standard planning and teamwork in the execution of all institutional tasks.

The academic planner is created each year by IQAC at the end of the previous academic year basing on the JNTUK calendar. The HODs will meet after the principal calls it.

The meeting will be attended by the HODs, Training & Placement, Senior Librarian, and Head of Physical Education.
